Program

Children Services

Park East Synagogue is home to New York's most popular and creative Shabbat Children's program. Each week children ages 2-6 participate in a Shabbat-appropriate art project that helps children understand the message of the weekly portion. Older children, ages 7-12, participate in our Junior Congregation, where they conduct a Shabbat service, learn about the Torah portion and are able to intertwine their School education with the Saturday services.

Bar & Bat Mitzvah

The Bar or Bat Mitzvah is a milestone in the life of a child. It is the culmination of years of hard work and preparation to teach the young adult that they are now responsible for their actions and to shoulder the responsibilities and obligations of a Jew. Specific training for the service, takes place outside the school program. At Park East Synagogue, a Bar or Bat Mitzvah provides an opportunity to celebrate this momentous occasion in an environment that is warm and welcoming.
